

Landmarks of Higher Education at Craiova


1. The stage prior to institutionalisation (1848 - 1946)

2. The foundation of the first faculties and institutes (1947-1965): in accordance with Law 138/ 25 April 1947 on the founding and organisation of the University of Craiova and its Ephors and with the Decision of Ministry Council 894/ 27 August 1965. The first faculties are established: The Faculty of Agronomy (1947), The Agronomic Institute (1948), The Technical Institute (1951), The Pedagogical Institute (1959).

3. Founding and development of the Craiova Academic Centre (1966-1989): strengthening of the academic structure by the integration of 7 faculties with a total of 20 specialisations on the 1st of October 1989.

4. The development, restructuring and modernisation of the University of Craiova after 1990:

- new strategic priorities – restructuring of study programmes;
- infrastructure modernisation;
- the use of information and communication technology;
- the development of scientific research and integration to the international academic community.



Landmarks

Geographical position

The University of Craiova is the main high profile institution of higher education in the historical region of Oltenia (at the territorial-administrative level, it comprises 5 counties) in the South-West of Romania, bordered by the Danube river and the Sub-Carpathians. Craiova is the largest city in Oltenia and the sixth in the country in point of population, thus offering a rich cultural experience.



Status quo

Currently, the University of Craiova is a comprehensive structure, including 11 faculties, 2 autonomous academic departments and 45 research centers. The University of Craiova takes pride in its infrastructure (1 main building, 5 university campuses, 11 student halls of residence, approximately 300 lecture theatres and seminar rooms, 255 laboratories, 1 central library and 14 branch libraries, 4 research and development units, 1 university club, etc) and in the qualified human resource (946 teaching staff members, 215 non-teaching staff members and 796 administrative and maintenance staff members), as a warrant for the quality of the services provided to the 27,989 students and to the community in general.



Activities

The main activities of the Department of Quality Assurance run as follows:

- a) implementation of the University strategies and policies of quality assurance and enhancement;
- b) design and implementation of the criteria and methodology for the periodical evaluation of quality assurance;
- c) dissemination of the information related to the culture of quality and the quality assurance in high standing European universities;
- d) periodical survey of graduates and employers in relation to the quality of the educational services provided by the university, and initiation of subsequent debates at the Senate level;
- e) periodical audit of the manner in which faculties meet the requirements of the social, economic and cultural environment;
- f) monitoring of compliance with the principle of a student-centred education;
- g) counselling of the University entities in the process of drafting the documents to be submitted to the Romanian Agency for Quality Assurance in Higher Education (ARACIS);
- h) submission of proposals regarding the increase of the professional insertion rate of graduates, based on the annual statistical data provided by the Centre for Counselling and Professional Orientation;
- i) monitoring compliance with quality standards and legal provisions in the field of higher education quality assurance;
- j) drafting of institutional self-evaluation reports of quality assurance and enhancement.

The department coordinates the research activity. It is run by a director and it comprises:

- full-time staff carrying out the organisation and current activities specific to the department;
- part-time staff carrying out stepwise activities: site maintenance, database design, drafting of activity reports;
- associate members selected from the specialists of the University of Craiova or from other institutions.

The main objective of the Department of Research and Project Management is to provide assistance, counselling and logistic support to the academic community members with a view to developing research projects.

The department drafts analyses and reports on the research activities and proposes strategies of meeting the national and international standards in this field.

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Background

The teaching and scientific activities of the Department of Applied Modern Languages, with the goal of teaching Romanian as a foreign language, go back to the academic year 1972-1973, when the first foreign students came to the University of Craiova.

Make-up

Teaching staff: 25 members (out of which 1 Associate Professor, 7 Senior Lecturers, 13 Junior Lecturers and 1 teaching assistant)
Students: 62 undertaking Romanian language preparation courses, out of which 58 enrolled in Bachelor's programmes, 3 in the Master's programmes and 1 medical doctor on probation)

Objectives

- to plan, organise, coordinate and implement in a harmonized and cost-effective manner the teaching of modern languages (English, French, German, Spanish) for special purposes (humanities, social sciences, natural sciences, exact sciences, engineering, etc.), as well as of Romanian as a foreign language.

Background

The Department of Applied Mathematics was established following the decision of the Senate of the University of Craiova on 28 June 2001 as an autonomous department immediately subordinated to the Rector of the University of Craiova, subsequently reconfirmed by the University Senate's decision on 13 July 2012.

The University Main Building



The University Main Building, located in 13 Alexandru Ioan Cuza Street, was designed by Ion Socolescu and erected in 1890. The building pertains to neoclassicism and was, successively, the headquarters of the Palace of Justice and of the People's Council of the Oltenia Region. After 1972, a new wing was added in harmony with the original building to serve the University Library.





The Research and Development Unit of Banu Mărăcine



Purpose

The Research and Development Unit of Banu Mărăcine is located in the eponymous winery, renowned for its red, white and flavoured wines as well as for the "Roua Plaiului" brandy, presented at the International Exhibition of Inventions, Geneva in 1996. There it was awarded the silver medal for its softness, refined taste and for the genuine winemaking technology. Banu Mărăcine is one of the most appreciated 12 Romanian wineries producing brandy from wine.

Internships, research activities carried out by the teaching staff, implementation of research outcomes in production, production of seeds and seedlings, other activities related directly or indirectly to the object of activity.

Hruba, one of the largest wine cellars in the country, was built in 1984 and more investment was made until 1990. Hruba is the place the wines are kept in oak barrels to age. Underneath the cellar there is a second underground level: the wine cave. The oldest brands were produced in 1970. The wine cave houses 20 000 wine and distilled peach and plum brandy bottles.





The Fruit Growing Research and Development Unit of Vâlcea



The unit was founded in 1977 and covers a surface area of 148.20 ha; its mission is to invigorate and modernize the Romanian fruit growing, in general, and the Oltenian one, in particular, as well as to scientifically and economically integrate it to the European Union in full compliance with the European standards, securing the international competitiveness of fruit, bio-products and environmental protection.

The unit aims to provide the scientific, biological and technological infrastructure for the modernisation of the Romanian fruit growing and for the professional training of undergraduates, Master's students and doctoral students in the field.

Research activity

Research laboratories:

- Laboratory of genetics and improvement;
- Laboratory of reproduction and biotechnology;
- Laboratory of plants protection;
- Laboratory of fruit growing techniques and technologies.

The Grassland Research Unit of Preajba-Rânca



The research unit of Preajba

The research centre, located in the sub-Carpathian area of Oltenia, was founded in 1965, covering a surface area of 30 ha. Since 1990 the area has been diminished to 12 ha. The centre owns a building made up of a study room, a kitchen, a dining room, bathroom, two bedrooms for undergraduates and a bedroom for doctoral students. In terms of material assets, the centre owns the necessary machines needed for the preparation of land for the establishment of temporary grasslands. The research carried out in this centre resulted in 10 doctoral theses in the field of grassland as well as in more than 30 research contracts.

The research unit of Rânca

The research centre of Rânca for mountain and alpine grassland, located at an altitude of 1600 m in Parâng mountains, was founded in 1955, covering an initial area of 30 ha. The area has been gradually diminished to 2 ha of fenced pastures. Research has polarized all fields starting from pedology, botany, climate to fodder production, animal husbandry, etc. The experimental Centre has a wood-beam cottage , built in 1948. In 1967, the research centres of Preajba and Rânca were brought together in a single research unit: Preajba- Rânca, having a common objective.

SCDA Caracal is a research unit established more than 115 years ago and it is organised into two sectors: research and development. The research sector operates in an area of 235 ha and includes three laboratories:

- Laboratory of plant improvement and seed production;
- Laboratory of fodder production;
- Laboratory of plant protection.

The development sector operates in an area of 2, 2242 ha and comprises 2 vegetables farms: Farm No. 1 of Caracal and Farm No. 2 of Stoenesti.



The “Alexandru Buia” Botanical Garden




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Background

The “Alexandru Buia” Botanical Garden, covering an area of approx. 8 ha, belonging to the University of Craiova, was founded on the initiative and under the direction of Professor Alexandru Buia in 1952 as a scientific, teaching and training unit. The Botanical Garden is divided in the following sectors:



The Ornamental Sector is flat, starting from the visitor’s entrance on Iancu Jianu Street, and comprises 145 taxa. It provides a rich and varied collection of plants and a pleasant environment throughout the vegetation season.

The Romanian Flower Provinces, comprising 120 taxa, is located in the north, north-east and east of the Botanical Garden. To create conditions as close as possible to the ecological requirements of the species in different regions of Romania micro- and macro-hills, whose height ranges between 1.5 m and 30 m in relation to the surface of the lakes, were built.

The Systematic Planting Sector comprises a number of 1000 taxa and is located in the central part of the Botanical Garden. It includes the lake which is home to the aquatic plants and various species of birds.

It is organized according to the theoretical system of classification of plants developed Alexandru Borza in 1925, and the plants are grouped by scientific criteria, highlighting the transition from lower to higher levels (evolution) and the progeny of groups (phylogeny).

The World Flower Provinces includes 1200 taxa and is located in the south western part of the Botanical Garden. It features the following provinces: Mediterranean, Caucasian, central Asian, South-East Asian and North American.



The Cultivated Plants Sector is located in the north western part of the Botanical Garden, housing 225 taxa. It is divided into six fields: plant production, vegetables growing, trees, shrubs and herbs, vines and fruit trees.

The Greenhouse is located near the administrative office and is divided into 4 sections: The aisle greenhouse, The succulent plants greenhouse, The tropical and subtropical plants greenhouse and The reproduction greenhouse. In this sector 630 taxa are present.

The Rosarium is located in west and south west. The biological material used in the various sectors of the garden to replace the damaged plants is reproduced here.


The Museum is located in the hall of the administrative office and includes samples of seeds, fruits, drawings, charts, certificates, catalogues published since the establishments of the Botanical Garden.

The Herbarium represents an essential component in any botanical gardens. Holding a special scientific value, it is permanently available to teachers, researchers and students, as well as to all enthusiasts.

The Seed Catalogue ("Index seminum") is an annual scientific publication of The "Alexandru Buia" Botanical Garden, counting the 53rd issue. The "Alexandru Buia" Botanical Garden collaborates with 460 similar institutions in the country and abroad. It has established educational partnerships with various schools, participates every year in the 1st of June Flower Exhibition, hosts various events on ecological and environment protection topics.

The "Alexandru Buia" Botanical Garden is known both nationally and internationally, being affiliated with the International Association of Botanical Gardens since 1974 and with the Association of Botanical Gardens in Romania (A.G.B.R.) since 2001.





The “Marin Păun” Botanical Garden of Râncea, Parâng Mountains



It was founded by Professor Marin Păun, PhD, a disciple and close associate of Professor Alexandru Buia. This institution, located in Parâng Mountains, on the Novaci-Șușag route, at 1560 m in altitude, is a teaching and scientific research unit.

The Botanical Garden of Râncea is the ideal place for the internships of students in Horticulture and Geography.



The Botanical Garden of Râncea aims at the conservation of the rare and endemic species of Parâng mountains, the study of the dynamics of natural vegetation dynamics study of the plants and trees, cultivation of vegetables, herbs, bushes, etc.

A lake with a water surface of approx. 400 m², with an island, gazebo, benches, etc., creates a special atmosphere for all activities of this Botanical Garden under the listing plan.

The vineyard of Banu Mărăcine is one of the oldest and best known in Oltenia. In 1962, covering an area of 12 ha, The Research and Development Unit of Banu Mărăcine was set here, belonging to higher education horticulture.

Of the total area of the Centre, 600 ha are planted with noble varieties, suitable for producing red wines and white aromatic wines, making it an excellent Romanian brand: red wines such as Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Fetească Neagră and Pinot Noir, or white wines such as Sauvignon Blanc and Tămâioasă Românească.

Of the regional wines to be remembered, Cramposia, a white wine, which along with Italian Riesling and Fetească Albă and is used to produce high quality brandy. Banu Mărăcine is one of the 12 areas in Romania where brandy trademarks are produced with the designation of origin Roua Plaiului, which in 1996 won the silver medal at the International Exhibition of Inventions in Geneva.

History


1833: the first record of the house, founded by the Romanescu family, true patriots and outstanding members of the local aristocracy as early as 1486.
