The study involves collaboration between the department of Education and Social studies and the Teacher education both departments of VIA University College.

Introduction

All over the world we encounter problems and challenges in relation to health and living conditions that create a demand for creativity, new thinking and actions among professionals who are working for the well-being of children, young people and adults.

The overall aim in this semester is to work on improving health and living conditions by means of innovative processes and holistic solutions.

The applicants for this semester are international and Danish students studying to be teachers, or social workers, as well as students within the field of health and people who are interested in finding new ways of working to improve health and living conditions.

It is possible to focus on the following groups: children and young people with special needs, people with social difficulties and people with mental and/ or physical disabilities.

A social entrepreneur has a focus on inclusion and socialization processes including diversity and marginalization, for example preventive interventions for pupils in difficult learning situations.

An important approach in the semester is to work in co-creation processes to make children and young people producers rather than consumers, and involve cross-professional and cross-sectors perspectives, in order to obtain sustainable solutions.

During this semester you will experience four weeks of placement in various schools, institutions or organisations, and you will also experience an untraditional placement/field work, creating innovative solutions for specific challenges given to you by schools, institutions or organisations.

By means of the semester you will encounter new thinking, new approaches and acquire competences that will help you become an innovative professional with facilitation skills, a social entrepreneur in schools, in institutions, in private organizations or in your own company.
